



Lettering requirements for Hastings High School Trap and Skeet Team (effective year 2017+)

SUGGESTED OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

1. To offer high school athletic status to shooting sport student athletes.
2. To recognize the accomplishments and time commitment of shooting sport student athletes with a varsity letter award to those who meet the requirements as defined by the high school. Official high school athletic recognition is important to college applicants.

SUGGESTED QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR LETTERING

To be eligible for the Independent Provider Extra Curricular Lettering Program, the shooting sport student athlete must meet the following criteria:

1. ADMINISTRATION

Athlete must be a student of *Hastings High School* in grades 7-12.

Home schooled athletes in this school district are also eligible.

Athlete must abide by *Hastings High School* and Minnesota State High School Clay Target League activity requirements.

Athlete must adhere to all school district rules, policies and requirements concerning student activities including, but not limited to, attendance, conduct, scholastic standing and other eligibility requirements.

Athlete must submit all necessary documentation and associated fees to the school's Lettering Coordinator by *date to be determined*.

2. PERFORMANCE

Athlete must average 19 points or more per round in competition play at the end of the season.

Athlete must not miss any competition weeks during the season. Unless approved by coaching staff.

Athlete may but not required to participate in the State Tournament. If a member shoots a 23 to 25 at state and averaged 12 or higher for the season.

3. LONGEVITY

If a student athlete fails to adhere to the Qualification and Requirements for Lettering, the athlete forfeits the right to letter for that season.

SUGGESTED PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

Hastings High School letters, shooting sport patch, bars, and certificate will be awarded to the qualifying recipients at *the end of the year shooting event*. In addition participating students will be invited to be included in the clay target team photo for the school's yearbook.
